

Declaration of Intent of the World Slackline Federation

(translated from the 2011 German original)

Following, the intentions, as well as the future goals of the WSFed are presented.

Goals/Intentions

Goal of the WSFed is to form a community that manages to constantly improve the sport of slacklining and distribute it globally. Through that, a global infrastructure, as well as a platform for the exchange of information around the sport of slacklining shall be established. Statistics about accident probabilities and –reasons shall be compiled, in order to negotiate appropriate insurances. Through the entry in the WSFed, all members shall be covered by such insurance.

Moreover, the newest findings and information shall be published. Special emphases are (scientific) articles (e.g. about tree awareness), events, contests and news from the worldwide community.

There shall be the possibility to acquire a appropriate license to qualify as slackline trainer in order to perform as instructor in associations, at commercial institutions and in schools. Furthermore the trainer shall be able to specialize in various fields like therapy, highline or trickline.

Through the holding of competitions on regional, national and international level, slacklining shall stand it's ground as an independent sport. There shall be an international system of rules, through which the competitions can be designed uniformly to establish an international standard in order to provide a comparability of achievements that can be displayed in a ranking list.

Furthermore, the establishment of slackline parks shall be aided in order to oppose the tree problems on one side and to create areas, where like-minded people get the possibility to interchange and to pursue their interests on the other side.

Through youth- and development programs like holiday camps, gatherings, collective training, the people-uniting, educational, cultural and humanitarian significance of slacklining shall be permanently improved.
